




Masterchefs of TNREA




Students of Grade III were shown the model of the skeletal system by their Science teacher Ms. Pravallika and had learnt about the framework of bones and joints.

The museum, designed in the style of Buddhist Viharas, displays the Buddhist, Palaeolithic and Neolithic artefacts and ruins that were discovered during earlier excavations. The next day, they had visited the Ethipothala Falls, the waterfall which is a combination of three streams namely Chandravanka Vagu, Nakkala Vagu and Tummala Vagu. It is situated about 11 kilometres (6.8 miles) from Nagarjuna Sagar Dam. The excursion ended with much fun, enthusiasm and memories for life.

The highlight of the day was finally making it to the top of the unit, the ra-dome (radar dome) which had the Doppler Radar installed inside.



Primary Students at the Panchatantra Theme Park
